STABLING

Indoor stalls with shavings. You are required to bring **your own hay and water bucket**, no matter which board you choose. **Board is charged by the day, not night.*

1. \$15.00/day (you feed your own hay and clean and strip your own stall)

2. \$20.00/day (we feed your hay twice a day, you clean and strip your own stall)

3. \$25.00/day f (we feed your hay twice a day and clean and strip your stall)

PETS

Please do not bring pets

TIME

Clinics are 6 hours of instruction a day with an hour break for lunch.

Start time is 10:00 a.m. Riders will meet in the arena at 10:00 a.m. initially *without* horses. Approx end time will be 5:00 p.m. (We are on horse time after all!)

BREAKS
