DAILY CAMP SCHEDULE

(This is a general idea of how the camps are set up. Times are subject to change. We are on horse time after all!)

9:00 am - 10:00 am Theory Discussion

It is important to know where you are going and how to get there. Each morning we will spend time without horses going over together what we learned, our successes and our frustrations, and discussing different concepts as applied to the course outline.

10:00 am – 12:30 pm Instructional Time

In the morning sessions, Jonathan will teach specific exercises to help you advance in your horsemanship goals. This is structured teaching time where everybody is on the same page doing the same thing.

12:30 pm – 2:30 pm Lunch and Relaxation

2:30 pm – 5:30 pm Instructional Time

This is where you get to apply what you learned in the morning session. Consider this study time or practice time where you get to go out and play with your horse at your own pace under Jonathan's tutelage. Depending on the course, Jonathan will have various obstacles set up to help you develop what you learned in the morning session. The afternoon session is where we put things to a purpose and solidify each lesson.

7:00 pm Dinner

After dinner, go back out and play or just hang out with your horse watching the sunset. Or rest and relax around a campfire, enjoying the stars.
