FACILITY

Widmer Ranch, West of Okotoks, AB

Arena: Indoor, dirt footing

Seating: Please bring lawn chairs

Services: Private facility / Washrooms on site. No power hookups.

Directions: Take Highway 2 South from Calgary to Highway 2A exit (Okotoks turnoff). Proceed South on highway 2A through Okotoks to Highway 7 (Walmart, Sobeys, on the corner). Turn right on Highway 7 towards Black Diamond/Turner Valley. Proceed for approx. 7 km to 48th Street West. Turn right on 48th Street West and proceed around the bend to the end of the road.

STABLING

\$25.00 per night. Includes bedding for indoor stalls.

PETS

Please do not bring pets

TIME

Clinics are 6 hours of instruction a day with an hour break for lunch.

Start time is 10:00 a.m. You may check in at 9:30 a.m. Riders will meet in the arena at 10:00 a.m. initially *without* horses. Approx end time will be 4:30 p.m. (We are on horse time after all!)

BREAKS
