STABLING

Indoor stalls with shavings. You are required to bring *your own hay and water bucket*, no matter which board you choose. **Board is charged by the day, not night.*

1. \$15.00/day (you feed your own hay and clean and strip your own stall)

2. \$20.00/day (we feed your hay twice a day, morning/evening you clean and strip your own stall)

3. \$25.00/day (we feed your hay twice a day: morning/evening and clean and strip your stall)

PETS

Please do not bring pets unless on a leash and are safe and quiet

TIME

Clinics are 6 hours of instruction a day with an hour break for lunch.

Start time is 10:00 a.m. Riders will meet in the arena at 10:00 a.m. initially *without* horses. Approx end time will be 5:00 p.m. (We are on horse time after all!)

BREAKS

There will be an hour lunch break at 1:00 p.m. Bring a lunch or there are restaurants 10 minutes away.

TACK AND EQUIPMENT

Bring halter, lead rope, horseman's stick and string, saddle pad, saddle, bridle and/or hackamore.
